**Don't risk the lives of your family
by staying in a cold home.**

**If you have no other place to go, New York City
will arrange for a warm, PRIVATE and safe place
for you to stay.**

- **Living in a home without heat can be fatal.**
- **Prolonged exposure to the cold can worsen asthma, heart disease, and other conditions.**
- **You can develop hypothermia – dangerously low body temperature – gradually, and without noticing. Hypothermia can kill.**
- **You can die of carbon monoxide poisoning if you are using stove tops, ovens, grills or faulty space heaters to stay warm.**

**Pack your medications, identification
and other small valuables and move now.**

**Visit a NYC Restoration Center
to arrange a move to a warm place.

call 311 for help.**
